Job Summary: Minocqua Winter Park is seeking part-time Tubing Hill Attendants for the 2025/26 winter season. Hill Attendants work as a team to create a fun, welcoming and safe environment for guests using the tubing hill.

Tubing Attendants are responsible for the following:

- Work as a team to maintain a safe and fun environment
- Coordinate with Chalet Staff/Volunteers to distribute tubes to ticket holders
- Manage tow rope operations
- Maintain radio communication with Tubing Staff Members, Chalet Staff and Volunteers
- Communicate hill maintenance/grooming needs with Trails Crew

Required Knowledge and Abilities:

- Must be at least 16 years old
- Must be able to work weekends and daily (excluding Christmas Eve/Day) during winter break (December 22, 2025 - January 4, 2026)
- Must be willing and able to work outside in cold conditions for extended periods of time

Tubing Hill Attendants report to the Operations Manager. Hourly wage of \$16 per hour.
